

Scope of the New Curriculum

Part 1 is entitled "The Dreamers". It covers 3 lessons only. Part 2 is entitled "The Story of Jesus" and covers lessons 4 to 12. The general aim for this curriculum is to emphasize about God's desire to **connect** to HIS people and to fulfill HIS covenant with Israel and to us, as adopted children of God. That desire of God to connect with us demonstrates HIS faithfulness, HIS love and mercy for HIS own people. Lesson 2 will teach our students about God's way of connecting to His people and Lesson 12 will highlight the finality of our heavenly connection with our God.

Lesson 2: Joseph's Dream

Main Emphasess: As faithful in HIS promises, God will find a way to connect to HIS own people.

God will surely fulfill His plans to those who are faithful to Him.

Lesson Scripture: Genesis 37-44

Memory Verse: Genesis 28:15a

"I am with you, and I will watch over you."

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES: ATEOTL, the students are expected to:

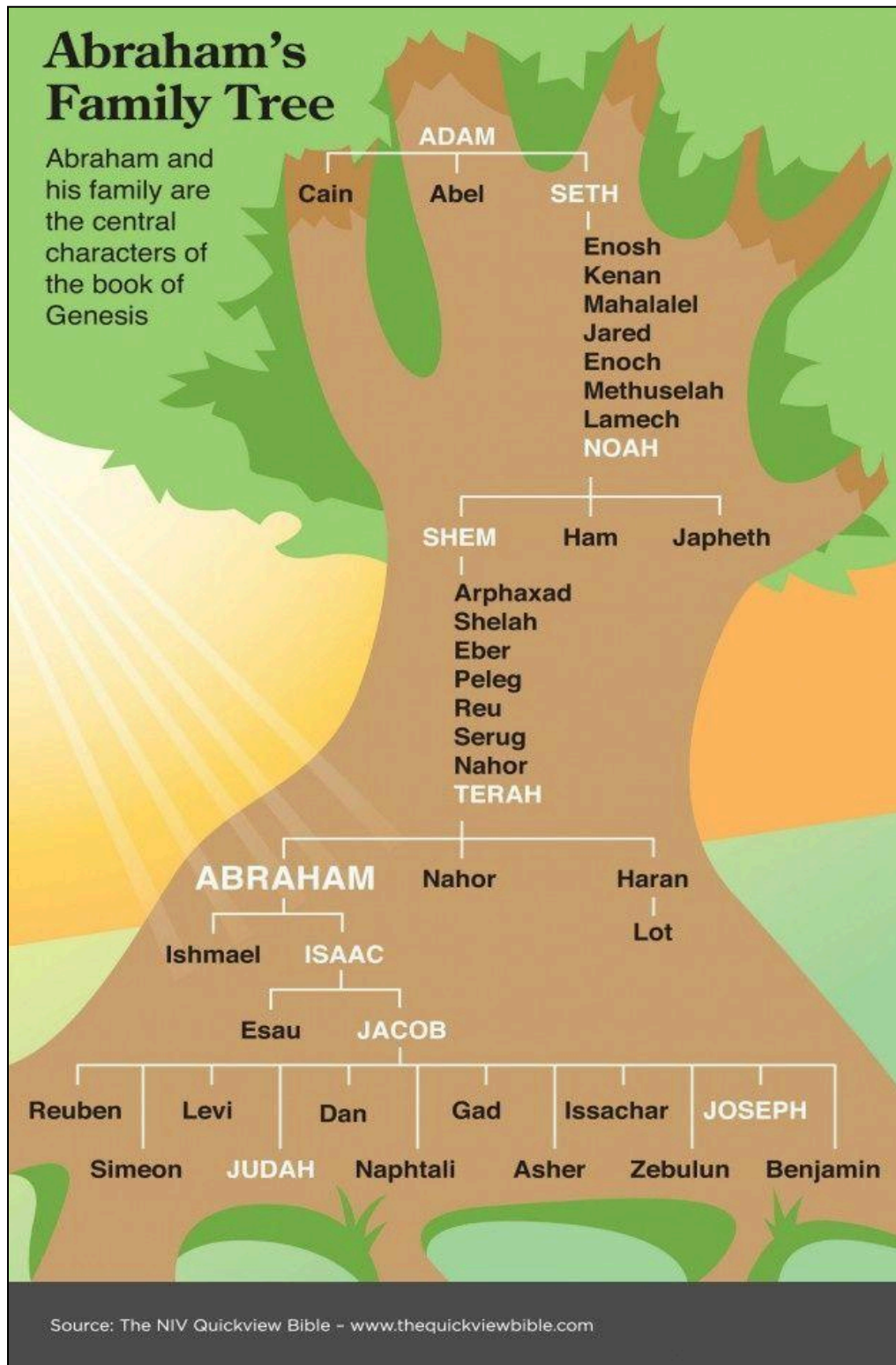
1. Name the son of Jacob and Rachel who can interpret dreams.
2. Tell the place where Jacob's family lived.
3. Trace and tell Joseph's family tree from Abraham.
4. Tell the dreams of Joseph that even his brothers and parents were unable to understand nor accept.
5. Name the place where Joseph became second in command next to the king.
6. Tell what happened to Joseph before becoming the prime minister of Egypt.
7. Explain why God brought Joseph out of slavery and imprisonment in Egypt.
8. Tell the purpose of God of making Joseph ruler and the significance of this with His promise to Abraham.

Clearing of Difficulties:

1. **Joseph** – son of Jacob and Rachel; the 11th son among the 12
2. **Canaan** – the home city of the Jacob's family.
3. **Egypt** - the place where GOD fulfilled the dreams of Joseph.
4. **Interpret** – to translate or explain for one to understand.
5. **Prime Minister** - second in command next to Pharaoh.
6. **Pharaoh** - the king of Egypt.
7. **Famine** - extreme scarcity of food.

DID YOU KNOW PORTION....

Focus on the lineage from Abraham as the father of faith.



Introduction: Can you remember any of your dreams? Can you explain what your dream was?

Bible Story:

V/O 1: Si Jose ay isang labimpitong taong gulang na lalaki, anak ni Jacob. Isa siya sa labindalawang anak ni Jacob at sila ay naninirahan sa Canaan.
V/O 1: Mahal na mahal ni Jacob si Joseph; ginawan niya ito ng isang *damit na makulay , at dahil dito, nagalit lalo ang mga kapatid ni Jacob sa kanya.
V/O 1: Nagkaroon ng isang panaginip si Joseph isang gabi. Sinabi niya ang patungkol dito sa kanyang mga kapatid kinaumagahan.
(MALE VOICE): "Napanaginipan ko na tayo ay nasa bukid at nagtatali ng trigo. Tumayo ang aking tinalian at yumuko sa paligid nito ang inyong mga trigo".
(MALE VOICE): "Ano?! Ang ibig mo bang sabihin ay maghahari ka sa amin?"
V/O 1: At lalo silang nagalit kay Jose. Lumipas muli ang gabi at si Jose ay nanaginip. Sinabi niya ito sa kanyang ama.
(MALE VOICE): "Ama! Nakita ko sa aking panaginip na ang araw, ang buwan at labing-isang bituin ay yumuko sa aking harapan."
(MALE VOICE): ""Ang ibig mo bang sabihin ay yuyuko kami sa harapan mo?"
V/O 1: Inggit na inggit kay Jose ang kanyang mga kapatid. Ngunit ang kanyang ama, ay inisip nang maigi ang mga bagay na ito.
Ginawan siya ng kasamaan ng kaniyang mga kapatid.
Itinapon nila si Jose sa balon at ibinenta bilang alipin. Si Jose ay napunta sa Ehipto.

V/O 1: Sa Ehipto ay pinagbintangan pa siya at nakulong.
1. Ang hari sa Ehipto na si Faraon ay nanaginip at walang makapagpaliwanag nito. Kaya ipinatawag si Jose dahil kilala siya na kayang magpaliwanag ng mga panaginip. At nang magawa ito ni Jose ay nakita ni Faraon na siya ay sinasamahan ng Panginoon kaya ginawa si Jose na prime minister o pangalawa sa hari sa Ehipto.
2. Nagkaroon ng tagutom sa lugar ni Jacob at kailangang pumunta ng kaniyang mga anak sa Ehipto dahil doon ay may pagkain. Nakita ni Jose na ang kanyang mga kapatid ay nakapila upang bumili ng pagkain.
3. Si Jose sa kabila ng mga nangyari sa kaniya ay hindi gumanti at tinanggap pa rin ang kaniyang mga kapatid. Nagkatotoo ang panaginip ni Jose, dahil sa posisyon ni Jose sa Ehipto at sa pagsisisi ng kanyang mga kapatid sa kanilang ginawa ay lumuhod at yumuko sila bilang pagbigay galang.
4. Dinala ni Jose ang kaniyang buong pamilya sa Ehipto. Tuwang tuwa si Jacob nang mabalitaang buhay pa si Jose.

Short Discussion

God is faithful to His promises. He loves to remind His people about His promises. Abraham, the grandfather of Jacob first received a promise from GOD. This promise was: He will make the descendants of Abraham as many as the stars in heaven.

In our Bible story, God gave Joseph dreams that He will rule among his family. He was sold by his brothers, became slave in Egypt and was imprisoned for something he did not do. God's faithfulness to Joseph and Joseph's faithfulness to God made his dreams to reality as he was able to interpret Pharaoh's dream and this made him prime minister. He was able to save Egypt and his family in Canaan from famine.

God's promise to Abraham of many descendants has been fulfilled with the help of Joseph whom God used to save His people from famine in their own land.

Life Application: Our faithful God will find a way to connect to us- to remind or guide us to obtain His promises. One way of connecting to us or with us is through a dream, just as Joseph dreamed of being a ruler and did rule in Egypt to save God's people and continue to multiply.

God is faithful ever since even today and will make a way to fulfill His promises to us as long as we are faithful to Him and do His will for our lives.

Evaluation: Ask questions based on the objectives given.
