Hand outstretched as if begging.



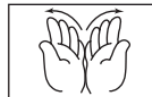

Presession:

A. Prayer/ Greetings at Circle Time

B. Guessing game: What's inside the box?

Fill each box with different materials and let your child guess what it is each time. Switch up the materials to keep it interesting. Keep in mind that they shouldn't look but to feel by using their hands what's inside the box.



Discussion:

Bible Story: Jesus feeds 5,000 people

Many(5,000) people followed Jesus and were hungry. Jesus asked the disciples(friends) how they could feed them, even though He already knew. Then a little boy brought Jesus his 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish he had for lunch. The disciple passed out the food to the people. The food never ran out. When everybody had eaten, the disciples collected the leftovers and there were still 12 baskets full.

Life Application:

Because the little boy in this story decided to share his food, all of the people were able to eat! God loves it when we share. When we share with others it helps them to know that God loves them and that they are special

Evaluation:

1. In our Bible story, who used his helping hands and shared his food with others? (the little boy who gives his lunch to Jesus)
2. How many loaves and fish did he share? (5 loaves and 2 fish)
3. What can we do to have helping hands?
