# Let's Trace! Color your heart with your favorite color below then trace the letters under it.




### **Materials:**

- Cut a small space for your bible to be inserted at the middle-top of your heart.








### **Materials:**


- Red-colored paper

- · Paste your memory verse on your heart.








### **Game Idea:**





Paste the picture that reflects a good heart at the red heart and stick the picture that reflects a bad heart at the black heart.




