


PHCC - CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL
TODDLERS – PRESCHOOL CURRICULUM
(Semi-detailed Lesson Plan)

APPROACH: Teaching Simple Bible Truth Blended with the Basic Learning of the Alphabet and Phonics, Numbers, Colors and Shapes

Objectives

1. Expecting that each pupil will learn  affectively about the love of God for us and the hope to be in heaven with HIM someday.
2. Also, expecting that the pupils will learn to trace or write the letter C and recognize objects and names beginning with Cc.

Basic Lesson: Recognition and Sound of the letter C; the Circle shape

Bible Connect: Christ, the Crown and the Cross

Scriptures:

- Luke 24:6-7 (King James Version)

⁶ He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee,

⁷ Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.

- John 11:25 (King James Version)

²⁵ Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live.

CLASS PROPER

A. Opening Prayer/Greetings/Roll Call

B. Basic Learning Introduction

- Set of new words beginning with letter Cc (supported by pictures please...)
 1. Cas in crown
 2. C..... as in cross

3. Cas in Christ

Note: Teacher, have a short discussion here about the name or title of Jesus as Christ, but no need to discuss the meaning.

Say: Kids, do you know that Jesus has a title or another call for His name, Jesus. He is Jesus the Christ or Christ. His other name begins with the letter C!



C.... as in CHRIST JESUS

PRESENTATION OF THE BIBLE STORY

(Picture storytelling from the book “Jesus is Alive by Shirley Dobson)

Picture 1(Jesus teaching and healing many people)

“Many people were getting to know Jesus. The people believed in Him.

Picture 2 (Soldiers got Jesus away)”One dark day, the soldiers came and took Jesus away.”

Picture 3 (a crown of thorns)”Men who did not want Jesus to live, put a crown on his head. But this crown is not a beautiful one but a crown so painful on Jesus’ head. It is a crown of thorns.



Picture 4 (Jesus Christ on the cross)

“He was nailed on a cross and died there. His friends were so sad and cried.

Picture 5 (Jesus tomb with a big round stone door)

“Jesus’ friends put his body inside a cave (tomb) and covered it with such a heavy round stone as a door.”

Picture 6 (Mary Magdalene visited the tomb of Jesus.)

“Then after 3 days, 1...,2...3, Mary Magdalene and her friends visited the tomb and was surprised to see, that the round big stone was open!

Picture 7: (2 angels inside with the good news)

“She looked inside and saw two shining angels telling her, JESUS HAS RISEN, HE IS ALIVE!”

Picture 8: (Jesus called Mary.)

“Then Mary heard someone called her...Mary! Its me. Mary turned and saw Jesus! He is truly alive!!

Teacher: “and now kids, Jesus is in heaven. He is alive!

He does not have the crown of thorns on his head. He is now a King with a beautiful crown!

When we get to heaven, He will give us a crown too!

Because of His love for us, he endured the pain of the thorny crown and the cross. He rose from the dead after 3 days to show us that we too can live again and get to heaven with him.

So when we pray to Him, he will hear us.

Closing: Let us all pray...

EVALUATION: ASK THE KIDS.

1. What is the title or name of Jesus that begins with the letter C?

Answer: C ...Christ

2. What was put on Jesus head by the wicked men?

Answer: a crown of thorns

3. What is that wooden thing which begins with letter c - where Jesus was nailed ?

Answer: Jesus was nailed on the CROSS.

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Suggested Activities:

- a. Writing or tracing letter C
- b. Encircle the objects beginning with letter C
- c. Spot and trace the circle shape in the picture (the empty tomb)
- d. Craft- crown making etc...
