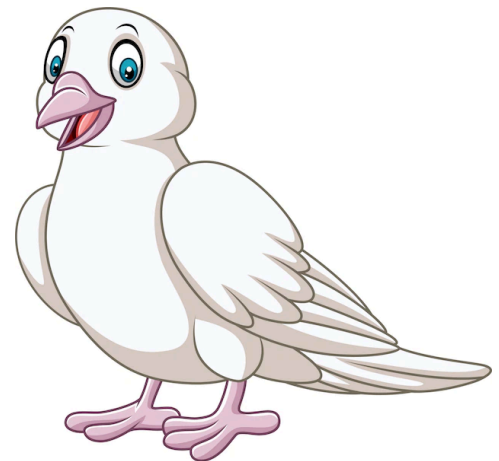
" To Jerusalem Jesus rode on a donkey, rode on a donkey, rode on a donkey.(repeat once)

• Ask the following:

1. What animal did Jesus ride on when he went to Jerusalem? (translate in Tagalog as you ask this question again)
2. "Donkey"(show pic of the animal with its name) begins with what letter? (make sure they recognize & identify letter Dd.)



Introduction to the new lesson

" We have a new lesson today kids. Are you ready to learn our new word?

Our new word is "Dove". (show pic with name) You see kids, this word begins with letter Dd too! Let's sing again..

D D D is for a dove....

Bible Story: Kids, our new story today is about Jesus and a dove.
