

Basic Learning Lesson: Recognition of the letter Ee; color green as well as the shape oblong

Bible Connect: GOD cares for His people (Deuteronomy 32:8-11)

Memory Verse:

Isaiah 40:31

“They that wait upon the Lord will be made strong.”

Teaching Aids: pictures of / video clips

- a) flying eagle
- b) eaglets on an eyrie (nest)
- c) eagle feeding its young

Main Emphasis: God is caring and protective of His people that He ought to be obeyed and honored.

Basic Learning: The Letter Ee as in *eagle, eaglet, eyrie*

Pre-session Activity: Art work using **color green** on trees. Distribute activity pages

Introduction to the Lesson:

Among the many birds in the sky, there is one kind which is called the master of the sky! It is the swift-flying eagle. With its broad wings and swift flying, it hunts for food to feed its young called eaglets.

The eagle can easily hunt and get food because it has a sharp vision. It can see well the running little animals in the field even at a high distance.

The eagle place its eaglet on a high eyrie-as what is called for its nest. The eyrie is made of sticks and branches with lots of green leaves too. The eagle housed the eaglet in so high trees and cliffs to protect the eaglets from predators.

Presentation of the Bible Lesson:

The Bible (*hold a Bible for the kids to see*) tells us God is a very caring God. He protects, and provides for our daily needs. Like eagles, the daddy eagle protects the eaglets from those animals that will hurt its baby, the eaglet and so the eyrie (nest) would be placed on a very high place. High up in the tallest tree or rocky cliff. Let me show you these videos.

Basic Learning:

We learned about eagles this morning kids! Can you say... eagle! (3x)
Eagle begins with letter Ee.

(*Show the letters of the Alphabet*). Can you point the letter Ee among these letters? (*Ask each kid*). What words in our study of eagles also begin with letter Ee?

Evaluation: Ask the words that begin with the letter Ee in the story of eagles. (eagle, eaglet, eyrie {“eeri”})

Enrichment: The Oblong shape of an egg

Draw or show images of circles and oblong with different sizes. Tell the children to point the oblong shape.

Suggested art work:

Make an eyrie for the eaglet. Collect sticks with some leaves. Place plastic eggs (find yellow or white shaded toy eggs)
