

LESSON FOR TODDLERS-PRESCHOOLERS

Lesson: Recognition and Sounding the Letter **Ff**

Approach: Teaching the Alphabet & Phonics with Simple Bible Truth

Bible Connect: The Second Plague (frogs): “Pharaoh’s Disobedience/Stubbornness”

Lesson Scripture: Exodus 8:1-15

Main Emphasis: The story teaches us to be submissive and not be stubborn.

Memory Verse: John 14:23 (NIV)

“Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching...”

Pre-Session Activity:

Prepare pictures that begin with letter Ff (flower, feather, fan, fish) also include the different objects that we previously studied (ark, birds, crown, donkey, egg) that are pasted on the wall. The teacher will say the names(object) that begin with the Letter F.

Class Proper:

A. Opening Prayer/Greetings/Roll Call

B. Basic Learning Introduction

a. Say or Sound the Letter Ff: **F! F! F!** is for **FROG**

Presentation of the Bible Story: (Picture Storytelling)

Moses went to Pharaoh and told him to let the Israelites go. But Pharaoh refused. God sent plague of frogs everywhere (houses, bedrooms). Pharaoh called Moses and Aaron, he pleaded to make the frogs go away, then he will let Israel go. Moses said TOMORROW! Can you imagine waiting yet another day to live with all these frogs? Do you see how stubborn Pharaoh was being?

Application of Bible Truth:

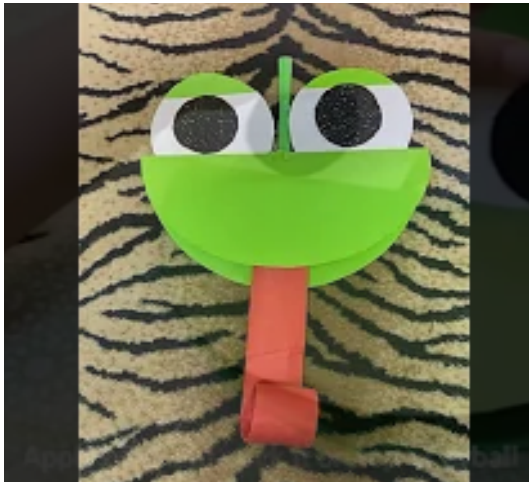
Today we began to learn the consequences of refusing to listen to God – Pharaoh's disobedience led to plagues coming from God. God's Word says that He resists the proud but gives lots of grace to those who are humble to God. We know that God is at work in our hearts, if we admit our mistakes.

Share also that the Bible says that God loves the children who obey their parents.

Evaluation: Ask simple questions about the Bible Story.

Enrichment Activities:

- A. Writing and Tracing Letter Ff
- B. Selection of the Letter F in a scrambled formation
- C. Crafts – Frog
