

Lesson for Preschool Kids (3 ½ - 5)

Basic Lesson: Recognition of the Letter **Gg**; How it Sounds and How to Write It.

Approach: Teaching Bible Truth Blended with Basic Learning
(Alphabet & Phonics; Numbers; Shapes and Colors)

Bible Truth: God is our Creator. Genesis is the first book of the Bible.

Bible Connect: [The Creation Story](#)

Lesson Scripture: Genesis 1; 2:1-2

Memory Verse: Genesis 1:1 (NIV)

"In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth."

Lesson Objectives: The students must be able to:

1. Recognize the Letter Gg;
2. Tell that God is our Creator;
3. Recite the memory verse with actions;
4. Say a praise or prayer of thanks for all of God's creation;
5. Participate in craft-making and work on the activities given.

Teaching Aid: Pictures of the following:

- a. Letter Gg;
- b. God;
- c. Bible (*Teacher may also use an actual bible or a big bible used in Toddlers' Class*);
- d. The heavens, the earth, and other living things mentioned in the Creation Story;
- e. Numbers 1 to 7.

Class Proper:

Pre-session Activities:

- Opening prayer / Greetings / Roll call
- *Do a simple stretching exercise then allow the kids to eat if they haven't eaten breakfast yet.*
- Review of past lesson: F is for Fish (Peter catches many fishes)

Suggestions on what to do:

1. Paste on the wall the photos used in the previous lesson/discussion;
2. Tell the children that God is our Provider;
3. Allow them to share what they are thankful for.

Questions to ask the children:

Teacher can choose 1 only from the questions below:

1. Kids, do you remember the name of the fisherman who caught plenty of fish? *Peter!*
2. Who is our Provider? *God!*

3. The word "Fish" begins with what letter? *Letter F!*
 4. How do you sound the letter Ff? */Ff/.../Ff/.../Ff/... is for a Fish!*
The teacher could present the letter Ff to the tune of "The wheels of the bus."
F... F... F... is for a fish (3x) F... F... F...
- Practice tracing the Letter **Gg** (*Please teach/guide the kids how to properly hold a crayon/pencil when writing*)

Note: Toddlers can use a big crayon/pencil and a blank sheet of paper in which they can scribble. This is to help them how to properly hold a crayon/pencil.

- Introduce the new lesson with a coloring activity — *I spy God's Creation (please include only a few illustrations)*

Introducing the New Lesson:

Today we have a new lesson for you! But, before I tell you our Bible story, I'd like everyone to close their eyes. What do you see? *Please wait patiently for their response.*

Did you know, kids, that our world used to be like this? It was dark! Nothing was visible! Not until God created light and all of the wonderful things we now have!

Ngayon ay mayroon tayong bagong lesson! Pero bago ko ikwento sa inyo ang ating Bible story, gusto kong ipikit muna nating lahat ang ating mga mata. Ano ang nakikita niyo?

Alam niyo ba, kids, na ganito ang ating mundo noon? Madilim! Walang makita! Pero si God ay lumikha ng liwanag at lahat ng magagandang bagay na mayroon tayo ngayon!

Presentation of the Bible Story:

Suggested teaching technique:

- *Picture story-telling*

Note: Please use the cut out pictures and paste them on the wall one by one while telling the story, or paste the pictures on the big bible and go through the pages one by one as you tell the story.

The Bible tells us that in **Genesis**, the first book of the Bible, **God** created the world. Because God created day and night, we have mornings and evenings! We have a lovely sky and sea because God created them! We have different plants and trees because God created them! We have light in the morning because God created the sun, and we have light at night because God created the moon and stars! God created all the birds, including the dove and eagle, as well as the various fishes! God created all animals, including camels and donkeys! And, of course, God created us, people! Everything was created by God, and everything was good because of God!

Mababasa natin sa first book ng Bible — sa Genesis, na nilikha ni God ang mundo. Dahil nilikha ni God ang day and night, mayroon tayong umaga at gabi! Mayroon tayong magandang sky and sea dahil nilikha ito ni God! May mga plants and trees tayo dahil nilikha sila ni God! Mayroon tayong liwanag sa umaga dahil nilikha ni God ang sun, at mayroon tayong liwanag sa gabi dahil nilikha ni God ang moon and stars! Nilikha ni God ang lahat ng mga birds, tulad ng dove and eagle, pati rin ang iba't ibang mga isda! Nilikha ni God ang

lahat ng animals, tulad ng camel and donkey. At, siyempre, nilikha tayo ni God! Ang lahat ng bagay ay nilikha ni God!

Life Application:

God created everything from the start. Because He loves us, God created all things to be beautiful. That is why we must thank and praise God every day because everything we have is a blessing from Him! Remember, kids, that God is our Creator!

Nilikha ni God ang lahat mula sa simula. Dahil mahal Niya tayo, nilikha Niya ang lahat para maging maganda. Kaya nga dapat tayong magpasalamat at magpuri kay God araw-araw dahil lahat ng mayroon tayo ay blessings mula sa Kanya! Lagi natin tatandaan, kids, that God is our Creator!

Evaluation: Ask questions based on the objectives given.

1. Who is our Creator? *God!*
2. What is our memory verse? *Genesis 1:1*
"In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth."

Enrichment Activity:

Suggestions for Beginner's Class:

It is encouraged that the assistant will create/suggest the craft and activity to be used in class.

- Tracing the letter Gg;
- Encircle the objects that start with the letter G;
- Create a small bible and paste the photos of God's creation.
