Lesson for Preschool Kids (3 ½ - 5)

Basic Lesson: Recognition of the Letter **Hh**; How it Sounds and How to Write It.

Bible Truth: Jesus is coming back for us!
Bible Connect: Jesus and His White Horse.

Lesson Scripture: Revelation 19:11-16

Memory Verse: James 5:7

"Be patient until the Lord's coming."

Lesson Objectives: The students must be able to:

- 1. Recognize the Letter Hh;
- 2. Tell that Jesus is coming back for us;
- 3. Recite the memory verse with actions;
- 4. Say a praise or prayer of thanks for God's faithfulness;
- 5. Participate in craft-making and work on the activities given.

Teaching Aid: Pictures of the following:

- a. Letter Hh;
- b. White Horse;
- c. Jesus;
- d. Jesus riding on a white horse.

Class Proper:

Pre-session Activities:

- Opening prayer / Greetings / Roll call
- Do a simple stretching exercise then allow the kids to eat if they haven't eaten breakfast vet.
- Review of past lesson: G for God and Genesis (God is our Creator).

Suggestions on what to do:

- 1. Paste on the wall the photos used in the previous lesson/discussion;
- 2. Tell the children that God is our Creator;
- 3. Allow them to share what they are thankful for.

Questions to ask the children:

Teacher can choose 1 only from the questions below:

- 1. Kids, last Sunday we learned that our Creator made the night time and day time; the sun, moon and stars, the sky, the seas and land, trees and plants, the animals then finally Adam and Eve. Then the Creator rested on day seven. Can you tell me now kids, who is the Creator of everything I told you about? God!
- 2. What is the first book of the Bible? Genesis.
- 3. The words "God" and "Genesis" begin with what letter? Letter G!

• Introduce the new lesson with a game — Step on the cut-out figures spread on the floor which begin with the letter H.

Suggestions on what to do:

- 1. Prepare cut-out images of: camel, donkey, dove, eagle, fish, frog, horse, house, hat, hand
- 2. Spread the figures or images on the floor
- 3. Ask each pupil to go to or step on the figure which has a name beginning with Hh. (The teacher/assistant may tell the children the names of the photos. Please pronounce the letter Hh clearly.)
- Practice tracing the Letter Hh (Please teach/guide the kids how to properly hold a crayon/pencil when writing)

Introducing the New Lesson:

Kids, look at this photo (*please show a photo of a horse*), this is a $\underline{\mathbf{h}}$ orse — $\underline{\mathbf{H}}$ o.r.s.e. Horses' colors can be brown, black, or white! Horses are known to be smart and strong animals! They can also run very fast!

Did you know, kids, that in the Bible, horses were used to fight against the enemies? The leaders of armies rode on horses to fight. But the Bible also says that Jesus will ride on His white horse to win the fight against our enemies; and that is to take us to heaven with Him!

Presentation of the Bible Story:

It says in the last book of the Bible (please show the book of Revelation to the kids/show in your Bible it's the last book), Jesus will come back for us! It also says that Jesus is Faithful and True. When Jesus comes back for us, He will be dressed in a robe with the title "King of Kings" and "Lord of Lords". He will ride on a white horse and the armies of heaven will follow Him, riding on white horses too!

Life Application:

When Jesus says that He will come back for us, He is true to His word because He will surely come back riding on a white horse! Kids, we must always be faithful to Jesus in any way we can, like going to church, praying every day, and obeying Him. That's why we must patiently wait for Jesus! Remember, kids, that Jesus is coming back for us!

Evaluation: Ask questions based on the objectives given.

- 1. When Jesus comes back, what animal will He be riding? White Horse!
- 2. The word "Horse" begins with what letter? Letter H!
- 3. Who is coming back for us? Jesus!
- 4. What is our memory verse? *James 5:7* "Be patient until the Lord's coming."
