Lesson for Preschool Kids (3 ½ - 5)

Lesson: Recognition of the Letter **Jj**; How it Sounds and How to Write It.

Approach: Teaching Bible Truth Blended with Basic Learning

(Alphabet & Phonics; Numbers; Shapes and Colors)

Bible Truth: God made us and He has a purpose for each one of us.

Bible Connect: JEREMIAH, the Young Prophet.

Bible Story: Jeremiah 1:1-3,5-9
Memory Verse: Jeremiah 1:5

"Before you were born, I knew you already!"

Lesson Objectives: The students must be able to:

- 1. Recognize the Letter Jj;
- 2. Tell that God knows us and has a purpose for everyone;
- 3. Recite the memory verse with actions;
- 4. Say a praise or prayer of thanks for God's faithfulness and His love for us;
- 5. Participate in craft-making and work on the activities given.

Teaching Aid: Pictures of the following:

- 1. King Josiah
- 2. Jeremiah
- 3. God

Class Proper:

- Opening Prayer / Roll Call
- Do a simple exercise and ask the children how their day was; it is important to stay in touch with the children.

- Review of the Past Lesson
- 1. Recall the memory verse

- 3. JOSIAH's name starts with what letter? Letter J!

Reference to connect past lesson to Jeremiah's story:

Jeremiah talks about God / Bible Story for Kids / Prophet Jeremiah Bible Story

"Kids! Did you know when King Josiah was still a king, there was a boy named Jeremiah, He is a young prophet. Kids, can you still remember the word, "prophet"? A prophet is someone who speaks for God and tells others about God! One day, God told Jeremiah "I knew you before you were born, That is when I chose you to speak words from the Lord." but Jeremiah said "But Lord, I can't speak for you, I'm too young. "God replied "don't say I'm too young, Don't be afraid, I will be with you everyday." says the Lord. Then God touched Jeremiah's lips and said "I've put my words in your mouth." So Jeremiah went to different places and told people about God!

Life Application:

"Just like God had some mighty big plans for Jeremiah, He also has some pretty big plans for you too. He knows your name. He knew you before you were even born and He has a plan for your life. No one knows us like He does, because He made us and planned for us for very special jobs. God knows me and God knows you too!."

Evaluation: Ask questions based on the objectives given.

- 1. Who was the boy that God talks to? Jeremiah!
- 2. JEREMIAH starts with a letter? Letter J!
- 3. What is our special word for today? God knows me.
- 4. Recite our Memory Verse. Jeremiah 1:5
