

Lesson for Preschool Kids (3 ½ - 5)

Lesson: Recognition of the Letter **Kk**; How it Sounds and How to Write It.

Approach: Teaching Bible Truth Blended with Basic Learning
(Alphabet & Phonics; Numbers; Shapes and Colors)

Bible Truth: Jesus is our King

Bible Connect: Jesus is the King of all kings

Bible Story: Luke 19:28-44 ; Rev. 17:14; Rev. 19:16

Memory Verse: [Luke 19:38](#)

"Blessed is the King who comes in the Name of the Lord"

Shortened version: "JESUS is our KING."

Lesson Objectives: The students must be able to:

1. Recognize the Letter Kk;
2. Tell that Jesus is the King of all kings;
3. Recite the memory verse with actions;
4. Say a praise or prayer of thanks to God.
5. Participate in craft-making and work on the activities given.

Teaching Aid: Pictures of the following:

1. Jesus
2. Horse
3. Crown

Class Proper:

- Opening Prayer / Roll Call
- *Do a simple exercise and ask the children how their day was; it is important to stay in touch with the children.*
- **Circle Time**

- Review the past lesson

The teacher may say to the children:

"Kids! Do you remember the name of the strong and faithful man who never complained and instead trusted God? That's right! His name is Joshua! Say it with me, kids! JO / SHU / WA. When people complained and doubted God when things started to get hard, Joshua did not complain because he was always full of faith in God. Let's recite our memory verse: Philippians 2:14 "Do everything without complaining and arguing."

- **Introduction of the Bible Story:**

- Have the children stand, march and sing along to the song.
- After the song, let the children sit down in their proper seats.

- **Presentation of the Bible Story:**

"Kids! Do you know what a King is?" Ask each student this question and acknowledge each answer. "Very good! All your answers are correct, but did you know that there is One King who is more powerful than any other king in the whole world? He is the KING OF ALL KINGS! Can you guess who it is? That is correct! His name is JESUS! Kids, say it with me JE-SUS."

“Did you know that when Jesus was entering Jerusalem people came out to welcome Him as their King? They gathered on each side of the road, and as Jesus approached, riding on a donkey, the people laid palm branches - like this one (hold a picture of palm branches) on the road in front of Him, saying "Blessed be the king who comes in the Name of the Lord". It was like they were preparing the way, honoring Him as the arriving King. “Kids! Did you know that Jesus will come again riding a horse, He's also wearing a crown too and on His thigh is written “King of kings...”

- **Life Application**

“Kids! Remember that Jesus is our King! Jesus will come again riding a horse, wearing a crown and on His thigh, it is written “King of kings..” That’s why God wants us to trust Him and obey His Word because He will come back for us.

- **Evaluation**

1. Who is coming back for us? [JESUS!](#)
2. What animal was Jesus riding on? [A Horse!](#)
3. What word does Jesus have on His thigh? [King of kings!](#)
4. What is our memory verse?
