LESSON FOR TODDLERS TO PRESCHOOLERS

Approach: Teaching Bible Truth Blended with Basic Learning

(Alphabet and Phonics; Numbers; Shapes and Colors)

Lesson: Recognition of the Letter **Oo**; How it Sounds and How to Write It.

Sub-topics: Number one (1) for the chapter in the book of Obadiah;

Circle and Oblong shapes; and blue color.

Bible Truth: We must obey God.

Bible Connect: Obadiah Obeys God.

Bible Story: Obadiah 1:1-21

Memory Verse: John 14:15

"If you love Me, obey Me."

Lesson Objectives

By the end of this session, the students must be able to:

- 1. Recognize the Letter **Oo**, number **1**, **circle and oblong** shapes, and **blue** color;
- 2. Tell that we must obey God;
- 3. Recite the memory verse with actions;
- 4. Say a praise or prayer of thanks for God's love;
- 5. Participate in craft-making and work on the activities given.

Pre-session Activity

Prayer Time:

Song: GOD IS LISTENING (Tune: Are you sleeping?)

God is listening (2x)

When we pray (2x)

Close our eyes so nicely

Fold our hands so quietly

Now, we'll pray (2x)

Review Time: Letter N for Nehemiah

The teacher may ask the children the following questions:

- 1. His name begins with the letter N and he helped rebuild the walls of Jerusalem, who is he?
- 2. Do you believe that God hears our prayers?

Circle Time:

The teacher may say to the children,

Kids, what shape is our mat? It's a circle and its color is—that's right, it's the color blue!

Can you help me identify which objects are blue?

- Show pictures of objects that are blue or place objects that are blue on the mat;
- Allow the children to choose which objects are blue.

But, kids, we have another shape here! It looks like a circle, but it's stretched a little bit. Do you still remember what this is called? It's an OBLONG! Today, we're going to learn about the letter O. The letter O is shaped like an oblong.

Worksheet (Optional):

- Tracing activity: Letter Oo, Number 1, Circle
- Coloring activity using a <u>blue</u> crayon: Color all the letters Oo, numbers 1, and circle shapes.

Bible Story Time:

Please show your Bible or use the big Bible used in Toddler's Class and tell the children that the book you're holding is called a Bible.

The Bible has many books! Today, we will study about <u>one</u> book in the Bible. It is the shortest book in the Bible, because it only has <u>one</u> chapter. This book is called OBADIAH. Say it with me kids, OW - BUH - DAI -UH!

Obadiah tells us about the *wicked* (*evil/very bad*) people who lived in the land of Edom (Edomites). The people in the land of Edom always disobeyed God and fought with the people of Israel (Israelites/God's people). You may ask the children if fighting with one another is right or wrong or if disobeying God pleases Him.

God loves His people, so God told Obadiah to warn the people of Edom that what they were doing was wrong. Obadiah loved God! So he obeyed God's Word and told the people of Edom about their wrongdoing.

Life Application

Do you love your mama/papa/nanay/tatay? Then what do you do to show them you love them? *Allow* each student to tell you how they express their love to their parents.

One way of showing we love them is by being obedient to them/obeying them.

In our bible story today, Obadiah teaches us to obey God. When God tells us to do something, what should we do? We must obey Him! Kids, we must remember that God loves us, and if we love God, we must obey Him.

Evaluation

The teacher may ask the children the following questions based on the objectives given.

- 1. What is the shortest book in the Bible that only has one (1) chapter?
- 2. What did Obadiah teach us in our bible story today?
