Lesson 3: Loving Others (Using Observation& Interview Approach)

Memory Verse: Matthew 22:39

I. Greetings/ circle time

"Children, can you remember the 3- letter word JOY that we have been studying the past Sundays? You may show them the letters or the letter J first.

Say: "Those who say they are glad to be here, will you raise your hand! " (seeing the smiles altho some may have the expression, "so??? () explain to them that their smile tells they have JOY!

Children, if its not for Jesus we will not be together today & enjoy our church. So you see, its Jesus who gives us this joy. And so today, we meet because we love JESUS.
