#### Introduction to the Lesson

Today we shall learn about the third of our statement of faith. (Show SoF#3 in big readable print.)

#### **Presentation of the Lesson** (Story for Kids)

For forty days, Jesus appeared many times to His followers especially the eleven disciples (Remember that Judas was not with them already.) They replaced Judas and had Matthias fill in the 12<sup>th</sup> position.

On the day that Jesus will go to heaven He told the disciples, "My Father will send you His promised gift. He will send you the Holy Spirit. Go to Jerusalem and wait for that promise." As he was finished with His speaking, a cloud received Him up and hid him.

When the Day of Pentecost came, all the friends of Jesus and disciples were gathered together in Jerusalem. Suddenly, the sound of a very strong wind came from heaven and tiny flames like tongues appeared touching each one of them. Then they began to speak in different languages they have never spoken before. Peter stood up and talked to the big crowd and told them to repent and God would forgive them of their sins. About three thousand people repented and believed in Jesus that day.

#### **Life Application**

Children, do you believe that Jesus Christ can baptize with His Holy Spirit? If you believe then you can also receive the gift of the Father, just as it was promised when Jesus went up to heaven. You too can receive that gift of the Holy Spirit so you can tell others about Jesus.
