

on 6d: Our Teacher, The Holy Spirit

SC. #6: "We believe that the Bible is the Word of God. Its Author is God Himself through the Holy Spirit."

Main Emphasis: Through knowing and understanding the nature and works of the Holy Spirit we will be able to understand that the Bible is truly inspired by Him- the Holy Spirit.

Lesson Scriptures: Luke 12:12; Acts 16:1-10; 2Peter 2:20-21; 2 Tim.3:16-17; 1 Cor.6:19-20

Scriptural References for Sub-topics :

- The Person of the Holy Spirit (1Cor.2:10-13; Rom.8:27; Ephesians 4: 30; Matthew 3:16; John 1:32)
- The Function/Works of the Holy Spirit (Gen.1:2; Psalm 37: 6; Job 26:13; Luke 12:12; 1 Cor 12:11)

Specific Objectives: At the end of the session, the students should be able to:

1. read Romans 8:27 and pick out the line that tells us that the Holy Spirit has his own mind about the things of God;
2. read Ephesians 4:30 and pick out the word that tells us the Holy Spirit has feelings;
3. read I Corinthians 12:11 and pick out the line that tells the Holy Spirit is a giver of gifts;
4. determine what kind of gifts the Holy Spirit gives to the saints;
5. pick out the part in the Bible story that tells the Holy Spirit as guide;
6. read Matthew 3:16; Mark 1:10; Luke 3:22; John 1:32 and tell the common truth known about the image of the Holy Spirit;
7. enumerate the 3 facts given that tells about the Person of the Holy Spirit;
8. tell their own understanding about this verse: 2 Samuel 23:2 "The Spirit of the LORD speaks through me; his words are upon my tongue";
9. Read 2Peter 1:21 and give their affirmation that it is the Holy Spirit who enabled men to write His words;
10. recall a memory verse taught to them telling that the Bible is God-inspired
